There are a lot of Little Free Libraries throughout MetroWest — not to mention the Greater Boston area! Maybe you're a parent or caregiver and looking for a fun activity for a morning or afternoon and want to hit up as many of these as you can. Or maybe you're an adult and want to keep this list handy if you happen to be in a specific area and it occurs to you, "hey, I could check out a Little Free Library while I'm here!"

You can always stop by any LFL that you happen upon — that's why they're there! But If you'd like to join the fun more formally, we encourage you to visit *different LFLs* and search for items on the attached page. Here are the "rules" for the MetroWest Readers Fest LFL Scavenger Hunt Bingo:

But if you would like to get in on the fun even more, feel free to send us selfies, pics of the actual LFLs (there are some really cool ones!), etc. If you have a public social media account, you can tag us (@metrowestreadersfest) on Facebook or Instagram and we'd be thrilled to repost. Or, if you send photos via email, we may follow up and ask if we have permission to share.

☐ A book from a series.
☐ A book set in another world or time.
☐ A book about food.
☐ A copy of either <i>Don't Ask Me Where I'm From</i> or <i>White Space: Essays on Culture, Race, & Writing</i> by Jennifer De Leon.
☐ A "golden ticket," i.e. a "reading buddy" lovingly created by a Sudbury resident. A "reading buddy" counts as two items!
